- Appropriate Swim attire required, no street clothes or shoes permitted in the pool.
- Glass door to the Health Club, Sauna & Steam rooms is locked promptly at 9:00 pm.

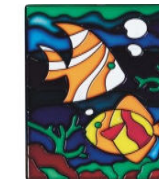
